

2021 Classical Chinese Poetry Recitation Contest for School Students

Reciting Chinese Traditional Poems & Experiencing Chinese Culture

Confucius Institute in Coquitlam hosted 2021 Classical Chinese Poetry Recitation Contest from October 12 to December 12. This contest was open to all the BC students from kindergarten to grade 12. The contest was in online form to display participants' talent reciting Chinese traditional poems. The contest groups were based on the grades with two categories of heritage and non-heritage groups.

This contest has received strong supports and responses from many Chinese teachers and students who were actively participated and displayed their different special styles reciting Chinese traditional poems. 105 students from K to 12 participated in this contest and they chose their favorite poems to recite in different ways with much creations. These poems included <Wanderin>, <Thinking in Quiet Nights>, <Asking Wine about Moon>, <Yueyang Pavilion>, <Man Jiang Hong>, <Jingjia> and <Snowy River>. Some participants also used the Chinese traditional music as the accompaniment for their reciting. This contest showed the achievement of the students learning Chinese language as well as the success of Chinese language education in BC.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the contest was organized on-line. All the participants submitted their poetry recitations electronically and all the judgments for this contest was also on-line. All the judges were experienced Chinese teachers and professionals to ensure the fairness for the judging. There were five judges altogether. For the calculation of the competition results, the judging committee took away the highest and lowest scores and the average score from the other three judges was considered as the final score for the contest. As a result, there were 79 winners who will receive the prizes, 11 First Prize, 30 Second Prize, 29 Third Prize and 9 Special Prize. All the participants will receive the participation certificates and all the winners will receive certificates and prizes. In regard of how to distribute certificates and prizes, Confucius Institute in Coquitlam will contact all the participants through e-mails.
