### 一、比赛时间和地点：

2023年3月4-5日，高贵林孔子学院-1100 Winslow Ave., Coquitlam, BC。成人组和温哥华当地学生组参赛的选手均以线下的形式参赛，外地的学生组选手可以在线上参赛。

### 二、参赛资格：

大温哥华地区本土棋手、加拿大其他地区象棋协会推荐的棋手、美国各地区象棋协会推荐的棋手、各协办单位推荐的棋手，均有参加本次比赛的资格。

### 三、比赛方式及相关规定：

1. 采用积分编排制（九轮）每局胜2分，和1分，负0分
2. 局时30分钟，每走一步加5秒
3. 每轮开赛迟到5分钟判负。
4. 成绩计算依次序为（多者在前）：大分、对手分、胜局、相互对战胜负，并列名次。
5. 未尽事宜，另行补充。本规程解释权归主办方。
6. 本次比赛采用世界象棋联合会通用的中国象棋竞赛规则

# 2023 Vancouver Open Chinese Chess Contest

In our joint effort to promote Chinese traditional culture and to enhance the exchange between Western and Eastern culture, as well as to increase the culture sharing and recognition among oversea Chinese people, Confucius Institute in Coquitlam, Chinese Language and Culture Institute in Coquitlam and Vancouver Chinese Chess Association is organizing this competition. All the Chinese chess lovers from North America are welcome to participate and share the enjoyment of playing this wonderful game.

### 1. Time & Location:

The dates for the competition are March 4 and 5, 2023. The event will be held at Confucius Institute in Coquitlam, 1100 Winslow Avenue, Coquitlam, BC. All the adult and local student participants are required to attend the competition in person. The student participants from outside of Vancouver region may attend the competition online.

### 2. Eligibility

All interested Chinese chess players from Vancouver region are eligible to register for the competition. The players from other regions in Canada and United States are required to be recommended by their local Chinese chess organizations or associations in order to register. The players recommended by the co-organizers of this competition will be eligible to register.

### 3. Competition Methods & Regulations

1. The competition will adopt a 9-Round Swiss System for pairing and scorekeeping. The player will be awarded 2 points for winning each game. If the game is drawn, each player will be awarded 1 point. The player will not receive any points for losing the game.
2. The time limit for each game will be 30 minutes. An additional 5 seconds will be added to the time limit with the completion of each move.

3. If the player is 5 minutes late for the game, he/she will automatically forfeit the game.
4. Tiebreaking: The ranking will be decided by tie-breakers in the following descending order of priority: Total points of players, total points of opponents, number of games won, direct encounter between the players.
5. Any rules not mentioned here can be introduced during the tournament if necessary. The organizers will have the final say in the interpretation of the competition rules.
6. This competition will adopt the Chinese Chess Competition Rules that are commonly used by the World Chinese Chess Federation.

#### **4. Competition Groups**

##### **Adult Group:**

Participants over age of 18

##### **Student Group:**

Participants – all students from kindergarten to grade12 (under age of 17)

#### **5. Award Prize**

##### **Adult Group**

First Place: \$800 CAD

Second Place: \$500 CAD

Third Place: \$300 CAD

Fourth Place – Eighth Place: \$100 CAD

##### **Student Group**

First Place: \$80 CAD

Second Place: \$60 CAD

Third Place: \$40 CAD

Fourth Place – Eighth Place: \$20 CAD
