# 2024年BC省中小学生中文写作比赛通知

为促进多元文化交流,为青少年学生提供汉语学习和语言实践平台,高贵林孔子学院现主办 2024年 BC省中小学生中文写作比赛有奖征文活动。本次征文活动从即日起至 2024年7月10日结束。活动主办方将聘请 BC省资深中文教师和中文教学研究专家组成评委团队,评选出各个组别的获奖作品,并举办征文比赛颁奖仪式,为获奖者颁发获奖证书和奖励。所有参赛者均将获得参赛证书。

比赛细则如下:

## 1.参赛者

本次比赛对 BC 省 K-12 年级所有中小学在读学生开放报名。参赛学生需为加拿 大永久居民或加拿大公民。比赛分母语组和非母语组进行。母语组的参赛者是父母 双方或任何一方为以汉语为母语者,非母语组的参赛者是父母双方均为以非汉语语 言为母语者。

## 2.参赛作品要求

写作题目:"未来的世界"

文体形式:本次征文的文体不限。

## 作品字数要求:

K-3年级: 文稿字数建议不超过150字;

4-6年级: 文稿字数建议不超过300字;

7-9年级: 文稿字数建议不超过 500字;

10-12年级: 文稿字数建议不超过800字。

## 2024 Chinese Writing Contest for K-12 Students in BC

In order to promote multi-cultural exchange and provide Chinese language learning and practicing platform for Chinese language learners in BC, Confucius Institute in Coquitlam is organizing Chinese writing contest for all K-12 students in BC, Canada. The organizer will invite experienced Chinese teachers and experts to be the judges. The winning writings will be honored with both certificate and prize in the award ceremony and will also be published in local Chinese media. All contestants will receive participation certificate.

## **Details of the Chinese writing contest:**

## 1. Contestant Categories

Chinese writing contest is open to students learning Chinese language from kindergarten to grade 12 in BC. All contestants should be Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada. There are two categories for the contest, "Heritage" group (one or more parents are heritage Chinese speakers) and "Non-Heritage" group (neither parent is a heritage Chinese speaker).

## 2. Entry Requirements

**Topic:** The Future World

## **Suggested word limits:**

Grade K-3: no more than 150 words; Grade 4-6: no more than 300 words; Grade 7-9: no more than 500 words; Grade 10-12: no more than 800 words.

## **Submissions:**

Please submit writings to http://xiezuo.bisai.ca. Entries can be either electronic or hand-written. Please photograph or scan the hand-written entry and submit it to the above website. Entries should be named in the following format:

Full name of the contestant +Grade+Heritage/Non-Heritage+School Name

Example: MaryZhang10HeritagePinetreeSecondarySchool

3. Judges

Experienced Chinese teachers and Chinese language teaching researchers will be invited

to be the judges for this contest.

4. Award

The organizer will be awarding First prize, Second prize, Third prize, Special Award and

Organizational Coaching Award. Every contestant will receive a certificate. Winners will

be awarded both certificate and prize.

5. Timeline

The competition is open from **now until July 10, 2024**. All entries should be submitted to

our designated web site before the deadline. The winners of the contest will be announced

online on July 31, 2024. Award ceremony will be held later with further notice.
